

It is often necessary to search for course information on PeopleSoft – when selecting elective courses, when looking for courses that fulfill Knowledge Areas or other Common Experience requirements, or if you are simply curious about what is offered.

After logging into PeopleSoft, select “Self Service” from the Main Menu. Then click on “Class Search / Browse Catalog”

You will be presented with the following screen:

Select show All Courses if you want to show all courses whether or not class sections are offered for the term. Select show Courses With Sections Offered to show only those courses that have class sections offered for the term.

You have two options – to show just those courses which are being offered during the semester in which you are searching, or to see all the courses that Clarkson offers. Note that if you do choose to view all courses, you must keep in mind that they are not necessarily all going to be offered in the semester that you are viewing.

For this demonstration, we are going to view all courses.

Next, click on the link for History to expand the list to view all courses. At this point, you can toggle back and forth between viewing all courses, and viewing just those courses with sections offered, by selecting the appropriate radio button in the “show” box.

You will then be taken to the Course Detail page, which displays catalog information, including the number of credits the course is worth, the default grading basis (whether the course results in a grade, or a P/NC), any Common Experience information (listed under “course attributes”), as well as a course description.

On the class search page, you can perform a simple search by entering in HIST as the Course Subject and 221 as the course number, then click Search.

By leaving the “Show open classes only” button checked, the search omits all courses that have 0 seats available.

To perform other searches you could try:

- Searching for the subject HIST with no course number to return all HIST courses with sections offered
- Search for the course number 221 if you are unsure of the subject, to return all courses numbered 221 with sections offered
- Click on ‘additional search criteria’ to filter results by instructor, days or times offered, course title keyword or type of course (lecture, lab, etc).

Don’t forget: only the first 3 sections are shown in the results. Click on View All sections or navigate through by clicking the arrows
