CLASS INFORMATION

If you need to add/drop sections of courses, you can do so through your PeopleSoft account. However, please keep in mind that it may be difficult to change sections. If a section you want to move to is "full", you will need to contact the professor (in person is better!) to see if you can obtain a permission number. The other suggestion is to go to the first class you want to get in to as there may be movement due to other students trying to change their schedules. If you need help, please contact either Brenda or Jenny. We have reviewed your schedule after the fall semester grades came out and have contacted you if there were any changes to be made especially if you had any grades below a "C" or you have changed your major. When the spring semester begins, you do have the first two weeks to add/drop any classes without notation on your transcript.

TUTORING

Louis Racette, TCS '10 and current Honors student, will be tutoring students again this semester who need assistance with physics and calculus (I and II for both subjects). Conor Cullinane, Honors student, will be tutoring students who need assistance with chemistry or calculus (I and II for both subjects). They will have a sign in sheet for each session so we know who is attending. The tutors we have hired for Clarkson School students only begins the week of January 16 - 20 through the entire spring semester and will be offered:

- Tuesdays, 7 - 8 pm in Price Hall Honors Classroom - Louis will be tutoring students needing assistance with Calculus (I or II) and Physics (I or II)
- Fridays, 3 - 5 pm in Price Hall Honors Classroom - Conor will be tutoring students needing assistance with Chemistry (I or II) or Physics (I or II)

The following dates outline the tutoring schedule from the Student Success Center. Online Tutor Requests will be available via your PeopleSoft account starting on Thursday, January 19th. The Tutoring Center will begin for the semester on Sunday, January 22nd from 7-11 pm in ERC 102 and will be available all semester Sundays through Thursdays. Tutoring for Calculus and Physics will be in CAMP 178 starting Sunday, January 22nd but will be available 7-11 pm for the semester Sundays through Wednesdays. All small group tutoring starts the week of January 22nd.
